


## New Energy, New Starters: Kicking off Basketball and Soccer Season

10. Frosty the Snowman-Magical snowman brought to life by a special hat, delighting children with his playful antics.




# WHAT IS THE BEST MOVIES TO WATCH THIS HOLIDAY SEASON?




### Home Alone (1990)




