Senior Chromebook Purchase or Return Process

OPTION TO PURCHASE CHROMEBOOKS

- In order to purchase you must complete the following before May 28:
 - Pay all lease fees owed (total \$100) to MO reception (Leslie Rebelo)
 - Pay all chromebook repair fees and turn in all hotspot devices with charger that may have been assigned
 - Must complete and have parent signed [chromebook contract](#) turned in

OPTION TO RETURN CHROMEBOOKS

- In order to return chromebooks students must complete the following:
 - Pay all fines and fees
 - Turn in all hotspot devices with charger that may have been assigned
 - Remove all decals, stickers, or graffiti (student will be fined if chromebook is defaced or damaged)
 - Turn in Chromebook and charger to Mission Oak on June 3th.

Any student who does not either purchase their chromebook or return it to MO will be fined the full cost of the Chromebook \$400.

Senior Fines and Fees

- All seniors have been sent a copy of their updated fines and fees over the last few months.
- All fines and fees should be paid with Mrs. Rebelo in the front administration office at Mission Oak. (Before school, during breaks, lunch, and after school)
- Any fines or fees remaining on student's account (except for lease fees) that are not paid by May 28 may result in the delay of graduates receiving their diploma.



20 Day Rule

School Board Policy requires that any student possessing, using, selling, furnishing, being in the immediate area of or being under the influence of any controlled substance, alcoholic beverage, or intoxicant of any kind, shall be suspended from school if the violation takes place:

1. While on school grounds
2. While going to or coming from school
3. During lunch period, whether on or off campus
4. During or while going to or coming from a school sponsored activity

This suspension carries a 20 School Day suspension from all extracurricular activities. This means that from Wednesday, May 8, 2025 and on, any senior suspended for a drug or alcohol violation will be excluded from participating in all senior activities including the Senior Breakfast and the Graduation Ceremony on June 5th.

Please do not disappoint yourself, your family, or your classmates. Use good common sense in these last few weeks of school.

Senior Attendance Policy

- Seniors must not have more than thirty (30) period absences throughout the senior year of high school to participate in commencement ceremonies.
- Seniors that have more than 30 period absences will still graduate and receive a diploma but will not be part of the commencement ceremonies.
- Saturday School attendance (all four hours) may clear an absence. Banking of Saturday School credit is NOT allowed.

Graduation Tickets

- **Each graduate can only invite 12 guests to graduation.**
 - No extra tickets will be given
 - Every person, including children of all ages, need a ticket if attending
- **Graduates who have guests that need special seating requirements must contact Mrs. Najera and fill out the [Graduation Special Seating Request Form](#) by May 28th.**
- **Tickets will be passed out to graduates at graduation practice on May 30th in the Gym.**

Graduation Practices

- This year there will be three graduation practice days: **May 22nd, May 30th, and June 5th.**
- You will receive a graduation seating chart prior to coming to graduation practice on **May 22rd.** Make sure to review it before coming to practice. Graduation Seating Chart is subject to change.
- Student will need to bring their cap and gown to the **May 30th** practice. Caps and gowns will be distributed Friday, May 22nd on the MOHS Football Field.

Graduate Expectations

- **Graduates are expected to be dressed appropriately for graduation.**
 - Young Men- slacks, shirt, tie, shoes (no flip flops)
 - Young Women-appropriate dress, skirt, slacks, blouse, sandals (No flip flops or spiked heels. Wedges and platform heels are okay, but make sure you have practiced walking in them).
 - Cap and Gown shall not be altered from its traditional form.
- **Do not Bring to the ceremony**
 - Purses, Money, Sunglasses, Valuable, etc.
 - Or anything else that will distract from the ceremony
- **Expectation during Ceremony**
 - Show respect to speakers, and presenters, Applause appropriately
 - Unruly behavior will be stopped and students removed or graduation will be stopped.
- **Reminder for parents:**
 - Every spectator at graduation must have a ticket.
 - Spectators are not allowed to bring in balloons, flowers or airhorns to the stadium. Please leave these items in the car.
